Hand injuries are common in the construction industry. Gloves are one of the most used form of PPE found in the workplace and glove manufacturers use high-tech fibers and materials to give excellent dexterity and protection.

-	Hand Safety Tips:

1	☐ Use tools instead of your hands when there is a danger of pinching or crushing.
2	
3	☐ Always use machine & power tool safety guards and never disable them.
4	☐ Make sure to wear proper fitting gloves & the right type for the job;
5	heavy duty rubber gloves for concrete work, welding gloves for welding, insulated gloves and sleeves when exposed to electrical hazards.
6	
7	☐ Use safety utility knives that limit the length of the blade and self-retracts.
8	☐ Do not put your hand in an area where you cannot see it.
9	
10	□ First aid training is important so you know how to handle a hand injury.
11	☐ When selecting cut-resistant gloves, the higher the ANSI (American National
12	Standards Institute) number, the greater the cut resistance.
