

KCA TOOL BOX TALK:

Hand Safety

Hand injuries are common in the construction industry. Gloves are one of the most used form of PPE found in the workplace and glove manufacturers use high-tech fibers and materials to give excellent dexterity and protection.

Hand Safety Tips:

- Use tools instead of your hands when there is a danger of pinching or crushing
- Always use machine & power tool safety guards and never disable them
- Make sure to wear proper fitting gloves & the right type for the job; heavy-duty rubber gloves for concrete work, welding gloves for welding, insulated gloves and sleeves when exposed to electrical hazards
- Use safety utility knives that limit the length of the blade and self-retracts
- Do not put your hand in an area where you cannot see it
- First aid training is important so you know how to handle a hand injury
- When selecting cut-resistant gloves, the higher the ANSI (American National Standards Institute) number, the greater the cut resistance
